Significant Events

Training Academy: The Phoenix Fire Department Training Academy opened on September 7, 2010, at 2526 W. Lower Buckeye Road.

800MHz Transition: Throughout 2010, the Phoenix Fire Department and many of its automatic aid partners successfully moved all non-hazard zone radio communications to the 800 MHz radio system.

Fireworks: On May 10, 2010, Arizona Governor Jan Brewer passed into law House Bill 2246, legalizing the use and sale of fireworks in Arizona. In December, 2010, the Phoenix City Council passed a city code making the use of consumer fireworks illegal in the city of Phoenix.
